

Discover Leuven's Hidden Gems

Make sure to visit all of Leuven's best (or worst) kept secrets!

Het Groot Begijnhof – the Grand Beguinage. UNESCO World Heritage and a great place if you're into romantic walks and photography.

Het Dijlepark - a beautiful little park with pond & bridge. Don't forget to take a picture with the Lucky Duck at the entrance for our "Leuven's Story in Statues" challenge!

Abdij van't Park - beautifully renovated abbey with large pond, nice bar/restaurant with terrace.

Het Mariapark en Kartuizerklooster - with not many people knowing it, this is really a hidden gem! Go up Bankstraat to discover the entrance on your left.

Sint-Geertrui-abdij en het Klein Begijnhof - Peace and tranquility in the centre of Leuven.

Visit the **tower and the carillon of the University Library!** - One of the only places to get a nice view of the city.

De Kruidtuin - Leuven's Botanical Garden. Great place to have a stroll and sit down and read a book in Spring.

See parts of the old **City Wall** in the Stadspark (city park), in the little alleyway starting across from St-Pieter hospital and in the Redingenstraat.

Arenberg Park & Castle – If you're studying in the centre, don't forget to pay a visit to the Arenberg Campus!

Abdij Keizersberg – On a high hill in the north of the city, this abbey offers you a great view of Leuven.

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Activities in the area:

Go running or picnicking at the "Provinciedomein van Kessel-lo"

In summer, visit the lake of Rotselaar and have a swim (bike trip!)

Visit the Museum and park of Tervuren (bike trip!)

Go climbing in Wavre!
